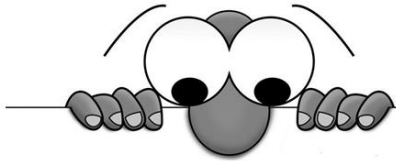

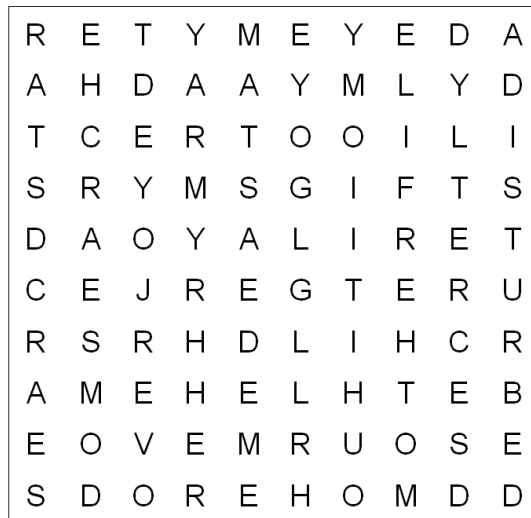


## Mini - Wordsearch

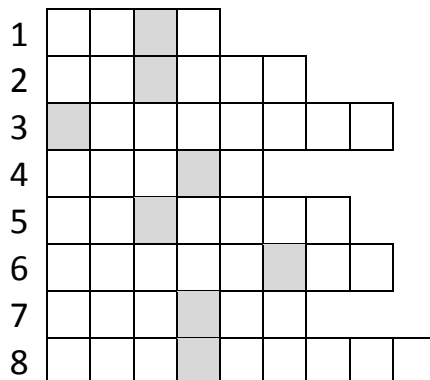

## Hidden Word Unscramble!

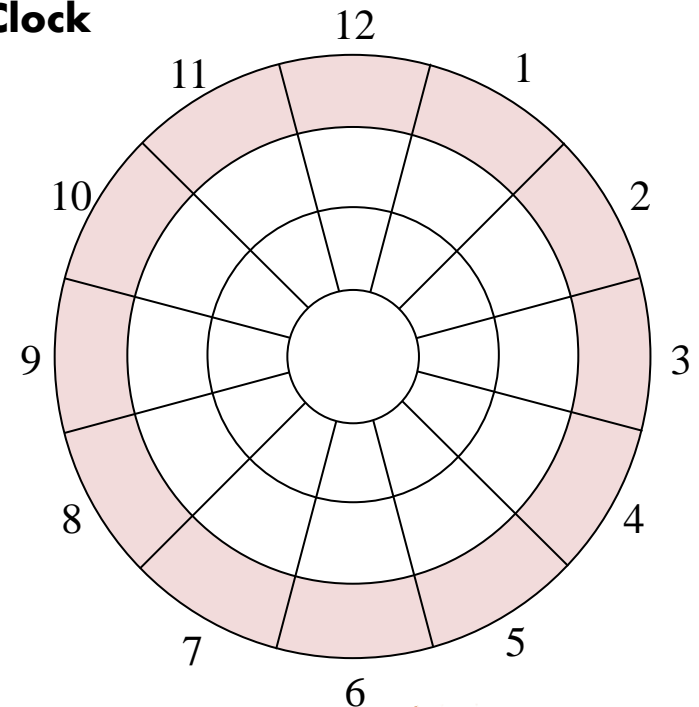
